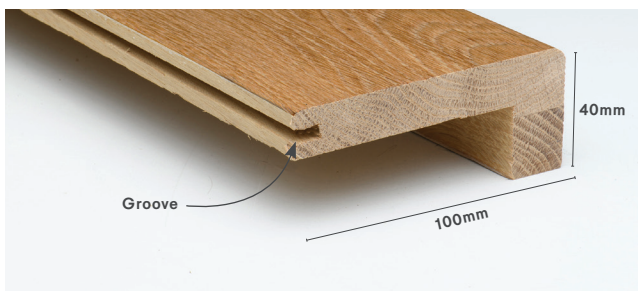

### INSTALLATION

Installation Method	Glue Down or Pin/Nail
Suitable Substrates	Plywood, Particle Board, Concrete, existing timber - enquire for others
Joint Profile	Groove (on tread)
Suitable Uses	Stairs in residential homes, hospitality, retail stores, restaurants, apartments (in commercial staircases additional slip resistance may be required)

## ARTISTE – SMOKED EUROPEAN OAK

---

Smoking is a wood finishing process that darkens wood and brings out the grain pattern. It consists of exposing wood to an agent which reacts with the tannins in the wood, resulting in a natural-looking colour change. Depending on the intensity of the treatment, the colour of the wood can be changed from light to dark brown.

Whilst smoking is colourfast, it is not a precise process. Different planks can react differently, resulting in boards from the same tree, and even different regions of the same board, having a noticeably different colour. These natural variations are unavoidable, and should be considered a feature of the end product.

## ARTISTE – RUSTIC GRADE

---

A rustic grade plank embraces the timber's natural character within the plank. Permitted knots, cracks and features achieves an enhanced natural look. The planks may have unlimited colour and grain variation.

Sapwood	None
Sound Knots	Healthy and well grown knots till 50mm allowed
Cracks and Out Falling Knots	Up to 25mm on diameter filled permitted
End Cracks	Occasional levelled up to approx. 150mm (but not usual)
